How Do I Use The Pathologists Lancet Kenya Evalyn-Brush®

1

Remove the Evalyn-Brush® from the packaging. Do not throw the packaging away, as it is necessary for sending the Evalyn-Brush® to the laboratory after usage.

Press the sides of the pink cap with your thumb and index finger to remove the pink cap from the Evalyn-Brush®. Ensure that you do not touch the white fibres of the Evalyn-Brush® with your hands!

Insert the Evalyn-Brush® up to the wings, push the plunger rotate x 5.
Carefully remove the Evalyn-Brush® and replace the pink cap.

Place the Evalyn-Brush® back inside the original package.
Put the package containing the Evalyn-Brush® into the plastic bag provided, seal it then submit to the laboratory.



Test Results

- Results are available within 1-2 days.
- Results can be sent via email.
- Results interpretation assisted by a trained staff.
- The prevalence of HR-HPV in Kenya ranges from 5-20% among HIV-ve women and 40-50% among those who are HIV +ve

What Do My HPV Results Mean?

- If the HPV test result is negative you are NOT at risk of developing cervical cancer and you do not need to test again for 3-5 years.
- If the HPV test is positive ,you need to see a gynecologist for further management.
 If positive for HPV 16 or 18, colposcopy should be done for biopsy or treatment on the spot.
- If positive for any other 12 HR-HPV subtypes (other than 16 or 18), a PAP smear will be done to guide the gynecologist on further management.

HPV and Cervical Cancer

- HPV (Human Papillloma Virus) has been established as the cause of cervical cancer. It is spread through close sexual contact.
- Most HPV infections clear on their own but in some women the infection persists leading to the risk of progression cervical cancer.
- Some HPV types carry a higher risk of causing cervical cancer (HR-HPV). These include HPV type 16&18 that cause >70% of cervical cancer.

- More sensitive than PAP smear (>95% sensitive compared to < 60% for PAP).
- Does not require speculum.
- Can be done on both self collected sample and one collected by your gynaecologist.
- Automated test (not operator dependent)
- Quicker results.

Self Collection Sampling (Evalyn-Brush®)

The self- collection kit is **Evalyn-Brush** * that is specially patented for collecting material from the vagina.

The Evalyn-Brush® has soft fine bristles ,ensuring that enough fluid and cell material is collected for testing in the lab. Evalyn-Brush® was designed by women for women.

Self – collected sample using the Evalyn-Brush® has been confirmed to be as accurate as cervical sample collected by a gynaecologist or a nurse.

Components of The Evalyn-Brush®

The Evalyn-Brush® is approx. 20cm long consists of transparent casing with wings. Within the casing is a pink stick consisting of a plunger at one end and white bristles at the other end covered by a pink cap. The pink cap is removed before insertion.

The bristles are exposed by pushing the plunger when inserted into the vagina up to the wings.
